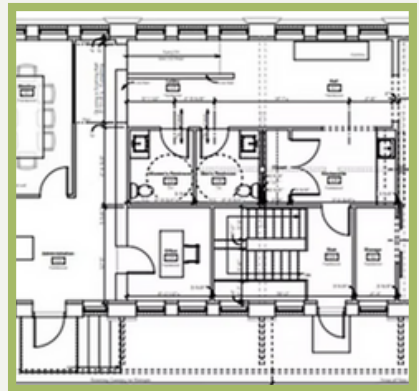

About the Storehouse

The Ludlow Heritage Museum (LHM) is working to preserve the last remaining historic building from the Ludlow Railyards, a Victorian Storehouse dating from the late 19th century. In partnership with Norfolk Southern Corporation, LHM has agreed to renovate the building into its new headquarters. The museum will revitalize a key landmark and enhance local tourism, education, and community engagement. LHM plans to restore the building, featuring exhibits, event spaces, and meeting areas.
